Request for advice of 24.07.2012 on the emergency planning for the Asse II mine

Against the background of the proposal to keep open the Asse II mine longer than initially planned, the BMU asked the Nuclear Waste Management Commission (ESK) and the Commission on Radiological Protection (SSK) in its advisory request of 24.07.2012 to review the planning of the Federal Office for Radiation Protection (BfS) on the emergency and preventive measures as well as further documents available on this this issue with particular emphasis on the assessment of the effectiveness of emergency and preventive measures with regard to the reduction of radiation exposure after an uncontrollable inflow of saline solution.
